

2014 BEST IN DAYTON (BID) SERIES RULES

WHAT IS THE BEST IN DAYTON SERIES?

The BID Series has been a long standing tradition in Dayton. It is a season-long, multi-tournament Points Series that crowns the Best Disc Golfer in Dayton, by division.

WHO CAN PLAY IN THE BIDS?

Anybody! You can play one, two, or all eight events but your odds are increasingly better of being crowned the 2014 Best in Dayton Champion the more events you play.

WINNERS

The BID Series winners in each division get an award at the end-of-year member's party, a free DDGA membership for the following year, and bragging rights to say "I'm the 2014 Best in Dayton Champion!"

HOW THE POINTS WORK

During each of the BID Series' eight (8) events, you will be awarded points based on where you placed in your division: 1 pt for First, 2 pts for Second, 3 pts for Third, and so on.

The overall objective is to have the FEWEST total points at the end of the season.

MISSING AN EVENT

If you miss a BID Series Tournament, you will be awarded a "NO SHOW" which is equal in points to the total number of players in your division plus one, then times two. For example, if there are 11 players in your division, a "NO SHOW" is awarded 24 points:

$$11 \text{ Players} + 1 = 12 \text{ and } 12 \times 2 = 24 \text{ Points}$$

A minimum of 10 Points for NO SHOWS will be assessed regardless of division size.

Below is a sample of a past tournament result and the points awarded for each Place:

EXCEPTIONS

Your two highest Point Scores from the eight events will be dropped, so only your lowest six events will count towards your end-of-season total. In other words, you will drop two of your worst scores. This will come in handy if you can't make a BID or two and have to take NO SHOWS, or have a really bad tournament and place poorly.

The only exception is the BID Finale which is worth **DOUBLE POINTS** and **cannot be dropped** from your total.

DIVISIONS

The following divisions will be available at all BID Series Events:

Open	Intermediate
Open Masters	Recreational
Advanced	Women
Advanced Masters	Juniors

It is **HIGHLY** recommended that the division you start in is the division you play in all season long. If you change divisions part way through the Series, you will receive NO SHOWS for all events in which you did not play in your new division.

SCHEDULE

The 2014 BID Series schedule is as follows:

August 2nd at Sycamore and Germantown

October 25th at Kettering and Belmont **BID FINALE!!**

Sign-ups for all events will start at 8:00 am the morning of the tournament and close at 9:00 am. Tee-off will be at approximately 9:30 am.

PRICING

Entry fees for all BID Series Events are as follows:

All Open Divisions: \$20
All Advanced Divisions: \$15
All Other Divisions: \$10
Non-DDGA Member Fee: \$3
Ace Fund (Optional): \$2
